
Emeritus Lawyers

Delaware Supreme Court Rule 69(g) addresses the membership category of emeritus status with the Delaware Bar. The rule requires emeritus members to be at least sixty-five (65) years of age (younger applicants can seek a waiver of the age requirement). In addition, emeritus members may not seek or receive compensation or reimbursement for legal services and may only represent non-profit entities, 501(c)(3) entities, religious organizations, educational and governmental institutions, or except as otherwise permitted by the Court.

In 2007, 26 formerly active Delaware attorneys applied for and were granted emeritus status with the Supreme Court of the State of Delaware.
