

**Minutes of Council Meeting  
Bankruptcy Section of DSBA  
February 14, 2007**

The council meeting (on this snowy and icy day) was attended by two of the officers – Bill Sudell and Pauline Morgan – and the following committee chairs and co-chairs – Donna Culver (Litigation), David Stratton (Social), Kim LaMaina (for Greg Galardi) (Local Rules), Maggie Juliano (Technology), Norm Pernick and Jim Patton (Chapter 11) and Bob Brady (U.S. Trustee/Bar Relations).

1. Donna Culver reported that the Litigation Committee was pleased at the reception its suggestions for changes to the local rules had received.
2. Dave Stratton reported on the successful Third Circuit Bankruptcy Forum held in Philadelphia on February 1 and 2, 2007.

Kim LaMaina reminded us that the revised local rules that became effective February 1, 2007, together with a red-lined version showing changes from the 2006 Local Rules, are available on the Court's website. Kim also reviewed the major changes to the rules and reported that the Court and the Local Rules Committee have agreed to a yearly review of the rules.

Maggie Juliano, on behalf of the Technology Committee, will look into simplifying the process for a person who has entered an appearance in a matter to be removed from the list of those receiving electronic notifications from the Court when his or her work on a matter is completed. The Technology Committee is newly formed this year and we encourage anyone interested in serving on that committee to contact Maggie Juliano or Adam Landis.

5. Norm Pernick and Jim Patton will soon convene a meeting of the Chapter 11 Committee to discuss the role that committee can and should serve in the Bankruptcy Section.

6. Bob Brady reported that the U.S. Trustee/Bar Relations Committee is having a lunch meeting on February 15, 2007, at which the United States Trustee's office will discuss the formation of creditors' committees.
