Program Structure: Each week, students will meet at Delaware Law School to (1) complete **mock** exams during class on previously lectured areas of law or an MPT; and (2) receive instruction regarding the skills, strategies, and techniques necessary to successfully answer the mock essays and MPTs.

During the Saturday session of the last week of the Program Term, four mock exams will be administered to simulate the current format of the Delaware Bar Exam. No instruction will be provided during the Saturday simulated session. Accommodations for additional test time during the Saturday session will be provided upon request.

Facilitation: The substance and order of the material tested will align as closely as possible with the Barbri schedule and subject areas tested on the Delaware Bar Exam. **Participants will be paired with mentors who, ideally, will grade their mentee's exam responses weekly**, providing consistent and substantive feedback to meaningfully support each Participants' development and understanding.
